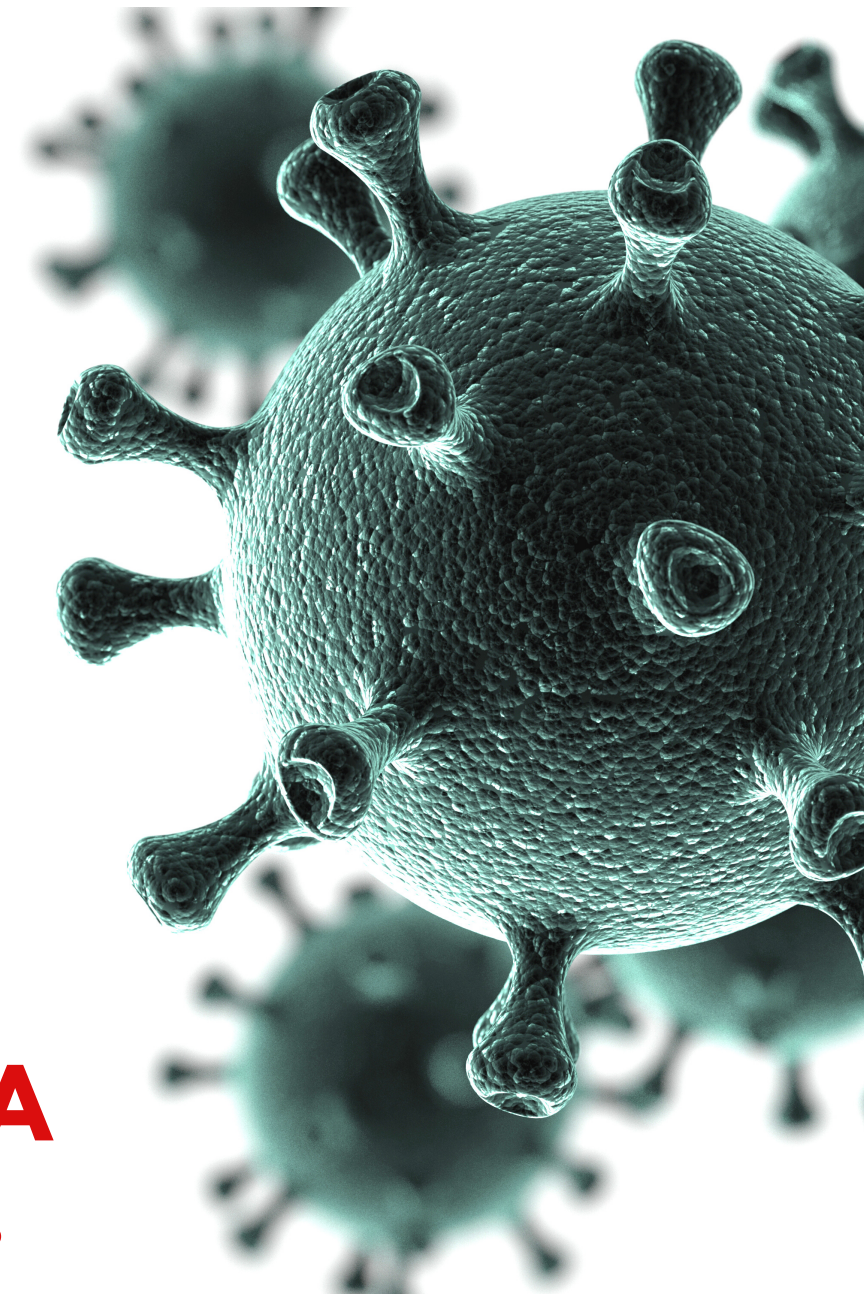




COVID-19 OUTBREAKS AND MEAT PROCESSING STUDY

Who are we?

We are a national team of healthcare researchers, doctors, and community members committed to improving the health and healthcare of essential food industry workers, their families and communities affected by COVID-19.

What is the study about?

Alberta's beef processing facilities have faced two of North America's largest and most rapid COVID-19 outbreaks. These outbreaks are not well understood and to prevent future outbreaks need to be studied. We aim to understand:

1. **Why and how they happened, and how we can prevent outbreaks in the future?**
2. **How they have impacted our communities in Alberta?**
3. **What was the outbreak response?**
(What worked, what did not, what support you received, what challenges you faced)

What would I have to do?

- Complete an ONLINE 30 minutes survey AND/OR
- 1-hour VIRTUAL interview (password-protected Zoom meeting)
- All information will be kept anonymous and confidential
- Survey and interview participants will receive a gift card for their time
